Attendance Policy

- **Absences** Call the school (570-207-9590) by 8:00 A.M. on the day of the absence. Send excuse in with child within three days.
 - 3 days of consecutive absences require a doctor's note.
 - A maximum of 10 absences will be excused with a parental excuse. All days beyond 10 days (cumulative) will require a medical excuse. *see student handbook for more information.
- Late After 3 tardy arrivals, students will be assigned detention for that and all continuing tardies.
- Excuses to leave early Students must bring a note to the office to leave early for a medical appointment. The parent/guardian must sign the "Excused" book in the **main office** before the student is permitted to leave the building.
- 8th graders are expected to complete missed work for absences.

- Reading for Accelerated Reader is their independent responsibility.







Sapphire - Grading Site






Google Classroom




Google Classroom- Access to classwork, quiz / test dates, and how to find work if your student is absent for any amount of time.
